


- 1) Open MKVToolNix GUI
- 2) Choose Header Editor
- 3) Open your file (drag and drop to the window also works)




- 4) Determine, through viewing or past knowledge of how a company sorts subtitles in a title, which subtitle is the one you want to be default (open in JRMC, start playback, right click the playing video, click Subtitles, determine which subtitle is the right one; top is the first subtitle track, one below that is second subtitle track, etc)




In this case, Korean is Subtitle track 5, Japanese is Subtitle track 6, and English is

Subtitle track 7 in my MKVToolnix example below



5) Click the sideways triangle for the proper subtitles



- 6) BE SURE TO SET DEFAULT TO **NO** IN ANY OTHER SUBTITLE TRACK. If you do not do this, JRMC will choose whichever subtitle file, in the language you choose, is the first track in the subtitle list. So if I had 3 English tracks here, and Sub track 5 and 6 are English, both are set to default, then JRMC will choose Sub track 5 as the default EVEN IF you want Sub track 6 to be The One.
  
- 7) Once you have set your default (and unset other defaults), save the file and exit MKVToolnix.
