[Release Date] *String, enter manually*

This is used for Series only. It is entered as the year the series was first released. For example, if a series was released in 1991 and finished in 2000, [Release Date] would be 1991. This allows us to distinguish between shows with the same name (Office, Battlestar Galactica) which have had multiple releases. This can be found on TheTVDb on the main series page, or alternatively as the date listed on IMDb.

[Season] is the season number as per TheTVDb

'S' for specials (pilot episode, specials etc)

'X' for extras (documentaries, interviews with cast etc)

'DVD' for single video files of a DVD with multiple episodes

[Release Date] is the first year a series was released.

I use this to differentiate between multiple release (Doctor Who, Battlestar Galactica, The Office)
